

The Greek word for “meet” is *apantesis*, [Strong 529], and means “a friendly encounter.” It is the same word used in 1 Thessalonians 4:17, “Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air.”

“Caught up” is also is an interesting Greek word, *harpazo*, [Strong 726]. It means “take by force.” On this day, the bride will be taken up by force to a friendly meeting with her Bridegroom! The Greek spelling of “shall be caught up” is *αρπαγησομεθα*, which is transliterated as “HARPAGESOMETHA” in English. These are its English codes:

Consider these codes: The multiplied code establishes the precise day on which Jesus was caught up from the tomb at the end of the 69th week; “But now Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep” (1 Cor 15:20) – [bottom table]

The following two codes of “HARPAGESOMETHA” help us to establish the precise day that the dead and living in Christ will “go out to meet Him” in the clouds in the air:
