

Are you in the Majority or the Minority?

In Matthew 7:13-14, Jesus said the majority of mankind will enter the wide gate that leads to destruction while a minority of people will receive eternal life by entering through the narrow gate. So which group are you in, the Majority or the Minority?

Matthew 7:13-14 "Enter by the narrow gate. For the gate is wide and the way is easy that leads to destruction, and those who enter by it are many. (14) For the gate is narrow and the way is hard that leads to life, and those who find it are few.

A few enter the narrow gate that leads to life by trusting in Jesus who is the one and only way to God

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

John 10:9 (Jesus also said) I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture.

In Mat 7:13-14 and Rom 10:9-10, the few who enter the narrow gate that leads to eternal life are those who believe the only way to God is to accept Jesus as their Savior who died on the cross for their sins and was raised from the dead after 3 days.

Rom 10:9-10 because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. (10) For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved.

Many will enter the wide gate that leads to destruction by following their own ways

The scriptures also say many will enter the wide gate that leads to destruction because they choose to follow their own ways by trusting in their self-righteousness and believing in everything that is a lie, rather than obeying the truth and trusting in Jesus who died on the cross for their sins and rose from the dead after 3 days, 2 Thess 2:9-12, Rom 2:8, 3:10, 19-20, Gal 2:16.

Proverbs 14:12 There is a way that seems right to a man, but its end is the way to death. Jeremiah 17:5 Thus says the LORD: "Cursed is the man who trusts in man and makes flesh his strength, whose heart turns away from the LORD.

Noah and his family are saved by faith from God's judgment of rebellious mankind

At 600 years of age Noah and his family were saved from God's wrath when eight people entered the ark by faith in the Lord while the rest of mankind perished in a worldwide flood of judgment because of man's wickedness and rebellion against God.

The wickedness of man was great in the earth and it grieved God's heart

Genesis 6:5-8 The LORD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every intention of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. (6) And the LORD regretted that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him to his heart. (7) So the LORD said, "I will blot out man whom I have created from the face of the land, man and animals and creeping things and birds of the heavens, for I am sorry that I have made them." (8) But Noah found favor in the eyes of the LORD.

Noah obeyed the LORD and built an ark that protected his family from God's righteous judgment of mankind

Genesis 6:13-14 And God said to Noah, "I have determined to make an end of all flesh, for the earth is filled with violence through them. Behold, I will destroy them with the earth. (14) Make yourself an ark of gopher wood. Make rooms in the ark, and cover it inside and out with pitch.

Noah and his family entered the ark to escape the waters of the flood

Genesis 7:6-7 Noah was six hundred years old when the flood of waters came upon the earth. (7) And Noah and his sons and his wife and his sons' wives with him went into the ark to escape the waters of the flood.

Just as people were unaware of God's judgment in the days of Noah, so will it be before Jesus returns

Matthew 24:37-39 For as were the days of Noah, so will be the coming of the Son of Man. (38) For as in those days before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day when Noah entered the ark, (39) and they were unaware until the flood came and swept them all away, so will be the coming of the Son of Man.

Noah and his families protection from God's judgment is prophetic for a remnant of Israel and minority of people throughout the world who will be saved by faith in Jesus during the Lord's end-time tribulation judgment for rebellious and unbelieving mankind.

The generation that sees the fig tree Israel blossom into a nation will not pass away before Jesus returns

Now what's important to recognize and prophetically understand is Jesus said the tribulation judgment for mankind will take place within the lifetime of the generation that sees Israel blossom into a nation in 1948, Mat 24:32-34.

Matthew 24:32-34 "From the fig tree (Israel, Jer 24:5-6) learn its lesson: as soon as its branch becomes tender and puts out its leaves (Israel blossoms into a nation in 1948, Isa 11:11-12, 27:1, 66:8), you know that summer is near (God's tribulation judgment of Israel and mankind, Amos 8:1-3). (33) So also, when you see all these things, you know that he (Jesus) is near, at the very gates. (34) Truly, I say to you, this generation will not pass away until all these things take place.

God's tribulation judgment will take place before the generation of 1948 passes away

As of 2018 those who were born in 1948 are now 70 years old. And within the next 20 to 30 years God's seven year tribulation judgment for rebellious mankind will take place when Jesus will return to save a believing remnant of Israel from their enemies who are plotting to destroy them, [before the generation of 1948 passes away](#).

Approximately 2500 years ago, Psalms 83 and Ezekiel 38 specifically mentioned the surrounding enemies that will try destroy the end-time nation of Israel during the seven years of tribulation. Below is a chart of [where the enemies of Israel live today](#).

In Psalms 83:4, Israel's enemies say, "Come, let us wipe them out as a nation"

In Psalms 83:3-4, Israel's enemies make crafty plans to destroy the Jews and they say, "Come, let us wipe them out as a nation;

Psalms 83:2-4 For behold, your enemies make an uproar; those who hate you have raised their heads. (3) They lay crafty plans against your people; they consult together against your treasured ones. (4) They say, "Come, let us wipe them out as a nation; let the name of Israel be remembered no more!"

The leaders of Iran are threatening to "[wipe Israel off the face of the earth](#)"

In 2005 Iranian leader Mahmoud Ahmadinejad described Israel as a "disgraceful blot" that should be "[wiped off the face of the earth](#)." And in 2015 Iran's supreme leader Ayatollah Akbar Hashemi Rafsanjani speaking of Israel said, "Eventually one day this alien forged existence that has been forced into the body of an ancient nation and historical region will be [wiped off the map](#)."

The prophetic scriptures reveal the generation of 1948 will see the tribulation and the return of Jesus

The Bible is the only book in the world that declares the generation that sees the rebirth of Israel will also see the return of Jesus. And the threatening war like events in the Mid-East and the enemies who are plotting to "wipe Israel off the face of the earth" proves that God's seven year tribulation judgment for wicked and unbelieving mankind is knocking at the door.

There is no one but God alone who declares the end from the beginning in the Bible

Isaiah 46:8-13 "Remember this and stand firm, recall it to mind, you transgressors, (9) remember the former things of old; for I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me, (10) [declaring the end from the beginning](#) and from ancient times things not yet done, saying, 'My counsel shall stand, and I will accomplish all my purpose,' (11) calling a bird of prey from the east, the man of my counsel from a far country. [I have spoken, and I will bring it to pass](#); I have purposed, and I will do it. (12) "Listen to me, you stubborn of heart, you who are far from righteousness: (13) I bring near my righteousness; it is not far off, and [my salvation will not delay](#); I will put salvation in Zion, for Israel my glory."

Are you following the Majority or are you in the Minority?

So are you following the majority who believe a lie and are walking down the wide path that leads to destruction in hell? Or are you in the minority and receiving God's gift of eternal life by entering the narrow gate through faith in Jesus as your Savior? Today is the day to trust in God's proven prophetic Word and accept Jesus as your Lord who died on the cross for your sins and is the only way to eternal life with God. Today if you hear God's voice do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion, Heb 3:15.

Choose this day whom you will serve

Joshua 24:15 And if it is evil in your eyes to serve the LORD, choose this day whom you will serve, whether the (imaginary and false) gods your fathers served in the region beyond the River, or the (fictitious) gods of the Amorites in whose land you dwell.

But as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.
