

## **THERE'S SOMETHING ABOUT CAUGHT FISH Netted 153 + Cooking ? = Total Fish ?**

Let's say you are the resurrected Jesus. I know this is difficult now but remember, we also will have incorruptible bodies soon so just pretend that the rapture has happened. Anyway, go back and be Jesus and imagine it is a few days before your ascension. You have seen the disciples on numerous occasions since the resurrection. You are seeing daybreak at the Sea of Galilee. As day breaks (as if you could not see in the dark), you see them again. You are now standing on the shore and you see some of your disciples out in a boat, fishing, unsuccessfully, a hundred yards or so off the shore.

You know there are seven of your disciples out there. You know where the fish are. You know none are in their boat right now. I'm not positive if you are omniscient yet but you sure know a lot more than a regular man. You or your Father (admitted this is prior to your glorification) know when the rapture is. You know you are going to accomplish a scene here that will become a favorite story of many, many disciples throughout history. It deals with the resurrection (netted unescaping fish being drawn to Jesus) which the disciples will soon learn from Paul is a resurrection event talking about the rapture of the Church. You also know the disciples have fished all night at Peter's urging and they are hungry and tired and maybe a little aggravated at Peter for this.

So you prepare a meal for them. With what? Fish! How did You get fish? We are not told. Hey, if I was a fish and knew my grand purpose was to be food, and I knew my creator was a few feet away, I would swim up on the shore to present myself to Jesus for consumption. That's what every Christian does when they are saved. You make a living sacrifice of yourself to Him. I don't know if Jesus used a small net, a pole, or just commanded some fish to come to the shoreline, but He ended up with fish and hot coals on a fire on shore and He began to cook those fish while the disciples were finding out on the boat that they were not bad fishermen at all. Not now that they have had Jesus' help.

You know the rest of the story in John 21. Jesus yells out to the boat and asks how the fishing is. They respond with failure and Jesus tells them to drop the net on the right hand side of the boat. They do and the net, which does not break, which tells you that the hound of heaven will not give up on those that are His, is full of large fish. John says to Peter, "It is the Lord!" and Peter dresses (when raptured we will be dressed appropriately to meet the Lord), flings himself into the water (we will

fling ourselves into the air when raptured) and swims to Jesus for redemption and blessing (Scripture reports there will be a tumult at the throne with people trying to get near Jesus). The boat comes to shore, Jesus tells Peter to go get the net and that is when the 153 are landed. But there are other fish.

The 7 disciples are hungry. They need sustenance. Jesus has bread and fish. My very simple question is this, “How many fish per disciple did Jesus cook?” One or two? Or more? Why is this important? It may not be. However, the rapture did not occur on the 153 day countdown from the eclipse. That would have been January 21. That day would also have been 120 days from the Great Resurrection sign of 9/23/2017. Apparently, we need to add days to our countdown for the caught fish or ignore the number of fish entirely.

So if it was a “number of fish in John 21 countdown” then it is obvious now that I blew it concluding that 153 was the number we should be counting to. It was not just 153! THERE WERE MORE FISH! How many? We don’t know. But, however many were cooked for the disciples should be added to the 153 fish countdown. I want to add that number to my John 21 countdown that brought me at 153 fish countdown looking for a rapture on Sunday, January 21.

So how would that look? Let me chart it. A 153 fish count from the eclipse of 8/21/2017 brought us to Sunday, January 21, 2018. Then look at this...

1 fish per disciple (7 additional) works to a fish countdown on 1/28/2018.  
2 fish per disciple (14 added) works to a fish countdown on 2/04/2018.  
3 fish per disciple (21 added) works to a fish countdown on 2/11/2018.  
7 fish per disciple (35 added) works to a fish countdown on 3/11/2018.  
17 fish per disciple (119 added) works to a fish countdown on 5/20/2018 which is Pentecost Sunday.

There are 16 remaining Sundays until Pentecost. I am interested in 2/04 because it is the day of the Superbowl and I could see how Jesus could have cooked 2 fish per disciple. Further, it would be the third day after that FISA memo was released and as an attorney, I know what fruit of the poisonous tree means. That means there will be serious changes to the political climate here and in the world.

I also have to admit I am interested in 2/11 because then this following scenario would fit in. First, there is a video on YouTube done by “gevte” entitled Rapture occurs between NOW & April's New Moon, 2018?

In this video, at 33:33 there is a chart that shows a clear count of 2520 that ends and another 2520 count that begins on February 2, 2018, yesterday! as I am writing this. If that last count of 2520 begins the tribulation, in a “sense” and in a “count” the Church, if it is raptured out of here on February 11<sup>th</sup>, would have had “tribulation 10 days.” I have always wondered what the Smyrnian explanation of that is. It still goes with the Philadelphian expectation of not experiencing the hour of testing that is to come upon the whole earth. We will miss that hour of testing. BUT, in some way, perhaps we will experience the first 10 days of the tribulation because it started on that geve count. This all occurs, of course, before we are taken to heaven where we will see the tribulation start in earnest with scroll, the Lamb, the throne, the seals, trumpets, bowls and woes and all else, including FINALLY Revelation 12:5.

Then again, I have to admit that I am kind of intrigued by 7 fish per disciple (really small) resulting in a 3/11 rapture, because of Revelation 3:11 which says...

**“Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown.”** However, that is not for another 5 weeks.

BUT, the ever important question for every Christian right now, even though they did not realize it, is this, “How many fish were prepared for each hungry Jewish fishing disciple in John 21?” Did these Jewish disciples get one each (in which case there is something wrong with this counting method because that was last Sunday, January 28, or did they get a double portion of fish with two each? I kind of like the idea that the disciples, heirs, might get a double portion. Or more? If they ate 17 fish each actually the day count would end with the rapture on the actual next day of Pentecost, Sunday, May 20, 2018! But then there is that gluttony thing. 17 is a lot of fish, even sardine-like fish. Anyway, as much as I like that idea, I really think we are taken on a day that is not already highlighted with a feast day because Jesus said it would be an unexpected day. It is knowable (Amos 3:7) but it won’t be an expected day.

I am not going to deal with more than 2 fish per disciple right now. I hear that sardine-like fish thrive in the Sea of Galilee but I really do not want to have to do another article for fivedoves because we finally learn that each disciple had what...7 sardines or more?

However, take note, every Sunday between now and Pentecost as this countdown or really a “countup” (because we don’t know which Sunday of the next 17 Sundays before Pentecost) continues, represents for the 7 disciples another fish caught in John 21. Here is a weird statement that only a watcher would ever say. “I am really looking forward to the rapture of the Church on a Sunday and so I really want to know how many fish Jesus cooked for the disciples when they netted 153 large ones!”

In John 21, the Holy Spirit kindly let us know that there were 7 disciples present and fishing. This is interesting. The number of disciples present was more important than their names because 2 of them were not named. If God meant there to be a “day for a fish” count in this episode in John 21, (and of course, maybe He didn’t) then, in addition to the fish in the net, we need to know how many fish each disciple was blessed with by Jesus. Let me suggest that if you are reading this after 1/28/2018, the answer is at least two. If the answer was “one per disciple” you should have been raptured yesterday or if you are reading this on Sunday, the last part of that day in Israel occurs early Sunday morning here and that is usually before fivedoves John posts. So, if we are here and reading, lets consider two fish, then add 14 to the 153 and the 167<sup>th</sup> day is February 4. Super Bowl Sunday. Fascinating!!! With two fish per each of the 7 hungry disciples, the day count from the Great Sign goes from 120 to 134.

120 to 134!!!! Watchers?!?!? Does that number mean anything to you? It should, those are the Psalms of Ascent. Psalms 120 to 134!!!! What are you ascending to? The Throne of God in Revelation 12:5. Is this an indication we should use those days to get your hearts prepared for a NEW MEAT OFFERING which you yourself are going to make to the Lord when you get to the altar before God? I don’t know for sure but because it is a possibility I felt I had to submit this article for more invited embarrassment even though, at the end of the day on February 4<sup>th</sup>, it could be that I will simply be watching the Super Bowl and being offended by the kneeling players and the half time show.

Saints! Might be wrong, but prepare your hearts now and keep them prepared. Today is January 28, read Psalm 128 and meditate on it to prepare your heart for the rapture.

If this count was designed by God by fish and for fish, who sovereignly put in a hint with the Psalms of Ascent being from Psalm 120 through 134, with raptured

Enoch letting us know we can consider Gregorian calendar dates, we should perhaps have started counting days by meditating on Scripture starting with Psalm 1 after the date of September 23, 2017. I wonder if we looked at the Psalms, from 9/23/2017, looking at the number of that Psalm, and then what if that date may have a connection to events that may have happened on certain days counted from 9/23/2017?

I didn't word that well...Let me try to explain.

So let's say there is a man in heaven who knows the day of the rapture and has planned it from the beginning. The Word caused His Word to reflect that day. How? The first Psalm of Ascent, Psalm 120 is for 1/20 or January 20/21. God knew how many days it would best take to prepare a heart...oh maybe 15 days, then that is the reason for the 15 days each meditating on a Psalm of Ascent.

An example...Two days ago was January 25. I could not sleep that night before and as it approached the new day, I read the Psalms of Ascent for the next day which was January 25, I read Psalm 125. Then I went outside and told God, "I wish I knew this approach to the Psalms was what You wanted!" I asked for a sign, like a meteor in the sky that looking at these Psalms of Ascent like this was proper. I did not get a meteor. And at 1:30 in the morning in my backyard it was cold.

So, this looking for a shooting star sign got old quick and I went back in because it was cold and sat down in my chair and about 20 minutes later at 2:09am on the morning of Psalm 125, I mean January 25, there was a 4.1 earthquake with its epicenter not 5 miles from me! A good jolt. I sat up looked at the swaying lights and then looked outside where I had just been and saw the rolling pool water. Then I checked USGS and sure enough, about 3 minutes after the quake, it showed up on the website. It was initially a 4.1 with epicenter just up the road about 5 miles.

**Then** I remembered that 30 minutes before the earthquake I had asked for a sign. I asked for the wrong kind, I wanted a shooting star, but I got a sign. I doubt anyone in a hundred mile radius had just asked God for a sign to confirm a prophetic idea in His Word. There was more quaking. I am in California. In addition to the 4.1 there was a 5.9 and a 5.0 on that day in California. I was surrounded by quakes.

Was Psalm 125 for that day? Psalm 125:1 "Those who trust in the LORD are like mount Zion, which shall not be **s H a Ke N**, but shall abide forever."

I think if we studied events of each day from the Great sign, we would then

discover how much our Lord is involved in the day to day operation of this world. Had we started on the Psalms on the day of the Great sign of 9/23, we would have started counting the first of the 15 Psalms of Ascent on January 20, with Psalm 120 for January 20. Review the previous Psalms of Ascent before the one we should be reading today.

You will see there are textual connections with current events. Find them or be ready for them by knowing what the words are for your daily Psalm of Ascent. Then after today, as you are reading, for Psalm 128 for January 28...

Psalm 129 for January 29.

Psalm 130 for January 30.

Psalm 131 for January 31.

Psalm 132 for February 1.

Psalm 133 for February 2.

Psalm 134 for February 3. In reading Psalm 134 as Feb 4<sup>th</sup> appears... you have made it to the throne room.

When you add 153 + 14 days to 8/21/2017 in a “non inclusive” manner (8/22 not 8/21 as day 1) you get to February 4, 2018. This day is a Sunday, a potential rapture day, and there are no more Psalms of Ascent to read. But read Psalm 135 and pretend you are settling in to your new eternal home after the rapture. That Psalm 135 in that context gave me goosebumps. Read it and see. Hopefully, welcome to the Throne Room.

**Blessings Saints. Soon we rise and shine. Maranatha and “thanks for all the fish.”**

**THE RAPTURE DATE IS PERHAPS AT END OF BIBLICALLY  
SIGNIFICANT COUNTS FROM**

- 1. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Great American Eclipse Of 8/21/2017; and**
- 2. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Great Resurrection (Harvest) Sign Of 9/23/2017; and**
- 3. Will Complete a Count To Pentecost in 2018.**

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### **INTRODUCTION**

Let me tell you what I am going to tell you. I believe the day of the rapture could be identified for us by God and by Scripture. I have been a fan of Amos 3:7 for decades.

Amos 3:7 King James Version (KJV)  
7 Surely the Lord God will do nothing, but he revealeth his secret unto his servants the prophets.

This verse means, to me, that God has told His prophets when the rapture is. The rapture is something that God does. I am going to consider words from Enoch, from Elijah, from Moses, from Paul, from Peter, from David, and from other Prophets of God. God has told His prophets “when” in Scripture.

I continue to “suffer” under the conclusion that the Second Great Resurrection Sign of September 23, 2017 initiated a count to the Rapture of the Church. Of course it did. There will be a specific number of days from that Great sign until the Rapture. No one disputes that. The question of course is, “What is that number?” “How many days to our GATHERING?”

I first thought the number of days from the Great Resurrection sign of 9/23 to rapture was 50 days. “50” is an important Pentecost number. 50 days after His resurrection was Pentecost. And 50 days from the Great Resurrection sign of 9/23 turned out to be a Sunday, November 12, 2017, a nice Sunday that ended with a...nice Monday. (although there was a large earthquake on the 12<sup>th</sup> in Iran)

I next thought the number was 99 days, an additional 49 days later. The reason, the 50 day count in Leviticus seemed to start on what was day 50 so it was a double count of 50 where the last day to the count of 50 was also the first day of the count to 99. That last day was Sunday December 31, 2017, a nice Sunday that ended with a...nice Monday.

I next thought the number was 120 days. The reason, the obvious connection of 120 to the conception of the Church at Pentecost in Acts 2 and 120 days from the Great sign of 9/23 took us to January 21, a Sunday AND that day, January 21, was also 153 days from the 2<sup>nd</sup> Great American Eclipse so a double count blessing. Further, it was really a triple count blessing because January 21 was also 120 days until Pentecost. What an amazing Sunday this was. That last date of both counts was Sunday, January 21, 2018, a nice Sunday that ended with a...nice Monday and now we are at Saturday, January 27 and once again I am writing to submit something to John Tng at fivedoves. Some people never learn. Hopefully I am not one. I did learn that 1/21 was not the day of the rapture. So I am learning.

BUT NOW, through the very difficult and sometimes humiliating path through Biblically supported and yet incorrect conclusions in the past, I had to come to a final conclusion. It is here. At least I hope it is final.

For reasons that I will indicate in the next sections, that amended count, from both the 2<sup>nd</sup> Great Resurrection Sign and the 2<sup>nd</sup> Great American eclipse, count possibly to the end of the Church on earth, end on Sunday, February 4, 2018.

The reason for this revision is here. Before, as I considered the 153 fish story, I exclusively was counting fish in the net. I did not think I needed to include the fish Jesus had previously caught that day and He was preparing those fish for the disciples when, at the very moment when, the disciples (7 of them being there as indicated in John 21) were bringing their fishing boat back to shore.

I am presenting this idea. It is a theory. Not saying I am right, especially with my history of looking at 50, 99, 120 and now 134. However, when I might consider a day for the rapture, it must be a date that will bring God and His Scriptures exceeding glory so I write about each point and why that point could bring God and His Scripture Glory. I love it when God's action on a date specific brings God glory!!! Enjoy and consider Saints!

This date, February 4th, 2018 could be the termination of a count from the SECOND GREAT AMERICAN ECLIPSE OF 8/21/2017. The number of days from this very important sign in the sun until February 4, 2018 is 167. That number (if 2 fish per each of the 7 disciples) will include the number of fish Jesus caught earlier in the morning for the disciples, added to **the 153, the number of fish in the net**. Jesus wanted to make his disciples fishers of men. As witnessing and ministering Christians, we serve to fish, to get the unsaved interested in the bait,

the bait being the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Christians have used the fish symbol to refer to them for millenniums. So, how many fish? Well, in addition to the **153 the number of fish in the net, Jesus cooked more fish for the disciples on that day.** LETS GUESS FOR A NEW COUNT!

That date, 2/04/2018 is in fact another Pentecost sign because it will be 14 days from the **120** day sign on 1/21/2017 and 106 days till Pentecost on 5/20. Add the 14 (days from) to the 106 (days to) and whatever day between 1/21/2018 and 5/20/2018 will add up to 120 days. **120 is still a number that takes us to Pentecost.** This will be true for all the days between 1/21 and 5/20. You add the count from 1/21 to the day of interest and then add the count from the day of interest to 5/20 and it will always be **120**. Yes I am making this 120 day period from 1/21 to 5/20 the period when the Season of Pentecost will end. Probably though, before the new 2018 Jewish religious year begins in the month of Nissan.

For anyone who sees the Lord coming earlier. I hope you are right about the nearness of the rapture. In fact, if the 7 disciples each only received ONE prepared fish to eat, that would suggest a rapture on January 28, 2018, which is 7 days after January 21, 2018, and it is likely, if you are reading this, you are reading this on that day, January 28. So I hope the rapture comes at the last hour of this day if you are reading it or earlier, in which case you would not have a chance to read this.

In fact, if you read the Torah reading for the Sabbath before this Sunday, January 28, 2018, you may think that the rapture will occur on Sunday, January 28, 2018. It speaks of bones being removed to the Promised Land. However, it does not stop speaking after January 27. It still speaks. I could write a lot about January 28 and confirmations but I think the weight of the evidence makes the February 4<sup>th</sup> date more significant and this is for fish reasons, for Enoch reasons, for Psalms of Ascent reasons and for the reason of allowing the January 31 Blue Blood Moon Eclipse to be a sign, occurring beforehand, although just a few days beforehand. In any event, redemption calls to me and it resonates deep. "Lord, please come anytime before these counts are complete!" Amen.

Acts 2:20 King James Version (KJV)  
The sun shall be turned into darkness and the moon into blood,  
before the great and manifest day of the Lord to come

Saints! These things have happened as signs. The last blood moon tetrad ending on 9/28/2015 and the Second Great American Eclipse of 8/21/2017 have occurred.

Then the sign that God Himself called a “GREAT SIGN” occurred on 9/23/2017. There will be another blue blood moon eclipse on January 31, 2018. These signs are tied in to Acts 2:20 (Pentecost) not just by being signs “before” the day, but by actual counts and connections. We have seen the Blood Moons and Eclipses pass us by these last years. God knew it, He planned it. Now the next step for the Lord is to come, at least to receive us in the air.

I will show you the connections that have led me to suggest any Watcher should look at February 4, 2018 as a potential “LAST DAY” as the potential date of the rapture. I know, I know, I know ... you don’t need to tell me what you are thinking. I am a seasoned watcher. I know all the responses from non-watching believers, unbelievers, and other believers who are watchers but who are watching other dates or other feasts of the Lord. God continues to give truth as we approach the day. If we keep going back over and over the Book, maybe something will become clear that was not clear, or a new insight giving clarity to a verse we hadn’t even questioned as being one that needed clarity before.

If this idea presented here, with its confirmations in Scripture, is of the Lord it will grow. Now I have learned that this is not my truth. I don’t have to defend it. These are counts in the Bible. If it is not true it will fade away. However, I see a huge amount of spiritual beauty in what the Lord revealed to me about the counts to the termination of the Pentecost season since the week before Thanksgiving. I would like to share it.

As the musician John Fischer wrote, “I’m just one hungry beggar showing you where I found food.”

“Lord, let it grow or let it fade.” Amen.

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## A. A BIBLE BASED POINT\*

### 1.

#### THE FIRST COUNT: THE PENTECOST COUNT TO RESURRECTION AFTER THE SECOND GREAT RESURRECTION SIGN\*. **120 + 14 or 134 DAYS!**

Leviticus 23:15-16 King James Version (KJV)

**15** And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the sabbath, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven sabbaths shall be complete:

**16** Even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath shall ye number fifty days; and **ye shall offer a new meat offering unto the Lord.**

The Resurrection of Jesus was a GREAT SIGN. I hope we can all agree on that. GOD (and the **120** disciples) COUNTED days from the GREAT SIGN of Jesus' Resurrection, 7 Sabbaths and then on the next day, DAY 1 of the 50 day count in Leviticus 23:15, 16 as the disciples were gathered (and ready to wait the full count...if necessary...but it wasn't necessary), and, on the next day, a Sunday, the morrow after the 7<sup>th</sup> Sabbath, the fiftieth (50<sup>th</sup>) day after the GREAT SIGN OF THE RESURRECTION OF JESUS CHRIST is when God got Pentecost rolling in Acts 2. The effects of Pentecost started and continue presently and will UNTIL THE LAST DAY OF THE CHURCH'S EXISTENCE AS CORRUPTIBLE ON EARTH. The Holy Spirit will continue to indwell new believers until the Last Saint comes in. That event would clear the way for the rapture. And someday I want to meet that last saint. What a story he or she will have.

God gives us signs, and unlike Daniel who was told by Jeremiah that he and the people of Israel needed to count off 70 years after the sign of Nebuchadnezer's defeat of Jerusalem. We are not directly told the date of the rapture of the Church. But we know this:

1. God told the prophets (Amos 3:7)
2. Through Scripture we are told what the times would be like (2 Peter)
3. God wants watching Saints to show God honor by looking in Scripture with the Holy Spirit's help to draw out, to mine, the things that God in His Glory, has determined to conceal. They are not concealed to never be found. They are concealed to be found.
4. God told us that in these days there would be signs. Signs indicate that something will occur just ahead. We are getting closer because the signs have already occurred. If the signs occurred then let's count.

We are dealing with two great signs. First, what I call, the SECOND GREAT AMERICAN ECLIPSE of 2017. Why do I call this a “second” great American eclipse. The first great American eclipse occurred 99 years ago in 1918. It was also an eclipse that traversed the entire country of the USA. There will also be a third great American eclipse to traverse the whole country in 2024.

Second, In Revelation 12:1&2 there has been prophesied, a “GREAT SIGN” in the heavens, namely WHAT I CALL THE SECOND GREAT RESURRECTION SIGN. Have you been studying it? That sign is incredible and all the other retrogrades and conjunctions around it make it even more so. The sign is about a new birth. Not just the birth of a human! The sign is a sign for the birth of resurrected Saints. It is a RESURRECTION SIGN.

When Jesus walked from the tomb it was a RESURRECTION SIGN. What do you do when you have a resurrection sign? You count! AND THIS ARTICLE PROPOSES that from this GREAT RESURRECTION SIGN, as we now have passed 50, 99 and 100, without a harvest, and now day 120 without a harvest, we need to modify DAY 120 TO DAY 134. Why add 14 days? We are speculating about how many fish a disciple eats when hungry.

If Jesus prepared 2 fish each then we found 14 additional fish! And after Psalm 120 we have 14 more Psalms of Ascent to bring us to the last Psalm of Ascent, Psalm 134, where we raise our hands to bless the Throne of God.

If you are not convinced that the eclipse and the Revelation 12 event in the heavens was even a sign I have to believe you have not spent time with the incredible amount of information available. I think the best line up of articles is on the website Unsealed.org and under the subject “The Sign.” There are over 30 articles about the sign there. If you still do not believe that the astronomical event that occurred on September 23 was a sign, I am not spending any more time in this article trying to prove it and as a result, I don’t know why you would even continue reading this article. You need to go to that website first. However, in the interest of those who admit, “Yes, indeed, it was a “great” sign” and they admit that because God Himself called it a GREAT SIGN, I will continue.

When I originally published this article I thought that the count would terminate earlier. In fact, I found it amazing that when we count from the Great Sign of Revelation 12 for what I errantly called the LEVITICUS PENTECOST TERMINATION COUNT as follows:

Read the verses in Leviticus 23:15 & 16, I will put it right here again, and see if the count could be applicable.

15 And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the sabbath, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven sabbaths shall be complete:  
16 Even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath shall ye number fifty days; and ye shall offer a new meat offering unto the LORD.

Apply those verses here because perhaps the Pentecost Season will end at the end of a Biblical count:

- 1 The first Sabbath after – Sept. 30, 2017
- 2 The second Sabbath - October 7, 2017

- 6 The sixth Sabbath - November 4, 2017
- 7 The seventh Sabbath - November 11, 2017

15 And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the sabbath, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven sabbaths shall be complete:

16 Even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath shall ye number fifty days; **and ye shall offer a new meat offering unto the LORD.**

ALL SUNDAYS

**1 The morrow after the seventh Sabbath - November 12, 2017**

**50 The day of the end of the 50 day count - December 31, 2017**

**(God showed us that this count is not going to be used by Him because there was no harvest on December 31, 2017)**

With no rapture on November 12 or December 31, I can conclude from this that the termination of Pentecost will not be set forth on a date set forth in the Old Testament. Perhaps God will instead use some fishy New Testament Count and use that count (or THOSE counts) to count down to the termination of Pentecost, this most Gentile, and unique of Divine Appointments.

As Israel through the years celebrated Pentecost, they had no idea about the mystery of the Church and that the Jewish Pentecost in Acts 2 was a start date would be used to create a different “nation” of believers nor that there would be a nearly 2,000 year membership drive of the Church. Pentecost was instituted as a celebration that Israel thought would only EVER apply to Israel. Well now the church continues to increase to the level God had determined from the beginning and after that there will be no more. The season of Pentecost would have to be

terminated somehow and yet still be shown to be somehow **connected** to Pentecost. God is taking care of that now with His own countdown to the TERMINATION OF PENTECOST COUNT FROM BOTH:

- 1) THE SECOND GREAT AMERICAN ECLIPSE OF 8/21/2017. and
- 2) THE SECOND GREAT RESURRECTION SIGN OF 9/23/2017.

I see nothing in Scripture that says that Pentecost must end on the same day it started which was 50 days or 99 days, or a 100 days or a 120 days. I thought all of these counts to be highly suggested in my previous versions of this article. But I was wrong. God wants us to look more and consider all the fish.

BUT NOW THERE IS ANOTHER COUNT. And this second count is all the more compelling when considered in view of the resurrected Jesus. Let's learn about not only the **153** netted fish, but take a stab at considering how many fish Jesus had "caught" before the **153** netted fish. That story is here coming up in the next section.

2.

**THE SECOND COUNT: AN AMAZING DAY COUNT TO RESURRECTION/REDEMPTION AFTER THE SECOND GREAT AMERICAN ECLIPSE OF 8/21/2017. 153 + 14 DAYS!**

John 21: 3 Simon Peter saith unto them, I go a fishing. They say unto him, We also go with thee. They went forth, and entered into a ship immediately; and that night they caught nothing.  
4 But when the morning was now come, Jesus stood on the shore: but the disciples knew not that it was Jesus.  
5 Then Jesus saith unto them, **Children, have ye any meat?** They answered him, No.  
6 And he said unto them, **Cast the net on the right side of the ship, and ye shall find.** They cast therefore, and now they were not able to draw it for the multitude of fishes. 7 Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved saith unto Peter, It is the Lord. Now when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he girt *his* fisher's coat *unto him*, (for he was naked,) and did cast himself into the sea.  
8 And the other disciples came in a little ship; (for they were not far from land, but as it were two hundred cubits,) dragging the net with fishes.  
9 As soon then as they were come to land, they saw a fire of coals there, and fish laid thereon, and bread.  
10 Jesus saith unto them, **Bring of the fish which ye have now caught.**  
11 Simon Peter went up, and drew the net to land full of great fishes, an **hundred and fifty and three**: and for all there were so many, yet was not the net broken.  
12 Jesus saith unto them, **Come and dine.**

I had not considered this **153** fish count till earlier this year when I saw it in a comment on a youtube video and I just had to laugh out loud. I had taught on this Great catch number numerous times and had seen how amazing this number was. However, not till now did I see the connection to rapture/redemption. My other article of which this is a 2018 revision, was 80 pages long and did not ever get a chance to use this number even once. In that sense, I am so glad Jesus did not come back on the 31<sup>st</sup> of December, we would have all been happy of course, but there is SO MUCH to the number **153** and having it be a part of the count for the rapture, the gathering, the catching up of the Church, WILL BRING EVEN MORE GLORY TO GOD! I will show you.

One of the things about the number **153** is when you cube all three digits, they add

up to 153. But with three digits there is the Father, 1 (represents the God who is one), there is the Son 5 (represents Grace), and there is the Holy Spirit 3, representing the third person of the Trinity. Multiply each number by itself 3 times to get the cube and there you have it,  $153 = 1^3 + 5^3 + 3^3$  or,  $153 = 1 + 125 + 27$  The number is unique.

If you add the highest and lowest number from these six

**135, 153, 315, 351, 513, 531**

**135 + 531=666 153 + 513= 666 315 + 351=666**

**you will get 666 - an important number in the book of revelation. (Sent by Bjorn Jonasson from Sweden by email dated 01 Jul 2011)**

There is almost no end to the remarkable details about this number from a mathematical perspective. Some do not understand

### **The Meaning of Numbers: The Number 153**

The meaning of the number 153 centers around the New Testament event sometimes referred to as the miraculous draught or catch of fishes (John 21:1 - 11). It is only mentioned in the Gospel of John. This amazing miracle was performed by Jesus, after his resurrection from the dead, in his next to last appearance with his eleven disciples before ascending into heaven. By understanding what led up to this miracle of fishes we can gain a broader perspective of what the number 153 represents.

After his resurrection Christ appeared a number of times to his innermost circle of eleven disciples. He first showed himself alive to all the disciples, except Thomas, on the Sunday night after his resurrection (John 20:19 - 24). Eight days later he met with the disciples when Thomas was present (John 20:26 - 29). Then an unknown period of time later he met with all the apostles at the appointed mountain in Galilee (Matthew 28:16 - 17). It was sometime after this meeting in Galilee, but before Christ's ascension on May 18th, that the miracle of 153 fishes occurred.

One day Peter decided he wanted to go back to his pre-conversion job of being a

fisherman (John 21:2 - 3). Upon hearing his plans several of the other disciples (Thomas, Nathanael, James, John and two unnamed disciples) went with him to fish on the Sea of Tiberias (Sea of Galilee). The men fish for an entire night and catch nothing. In the morning, a man on the shore (they did not know it was Jesus) yells to them and asks if they caught anything. They answer no. They are then told to drop their net on the right side of the ship. When they try to bring the net out of the water it is so FULL of fish that it requires being dragged to the shore! The disciples now realize it was Jesus talking to them. On shore, Peter counts a total number of 153 'great fish' in the net.

Symbolizing abundance, 153 can even represent an OVERFLOW blessing from God. The Bible states the disciples marveled at the fact that their net held together even though it contained so many large fish (John 21:11)! Additionally, the catching of such a large amount of fish happened only after Christ became involved in the work. This is a subtle (or perhaps not so subtle!) reminder that without Christ the disciples' (and any believer's) attempts to accomplish something great on their own will fail, but that with Jesus all things are possible (John 15:5).

Lastly, the 153 fishes is reminiscent of a previously abundant catch Peter, Andrew, James and John experienced when they were first called to follow Christ and become fishers of MEN (and not food). Given the disciples were trying to go back to their pre-conversion employment when the miracle occurred, it likely reminded them that they now worked for God whose will it still was for them to catch men and not fish.

### **Additional info on the Biblical Meaning of the number 153**

We discover something quite interesting when we look at how many people, in the Gospel accounts, Jesus personally blessed.

The book of Mark records Christ, on a total of three occasions, personally blessed three people. These events were the healing of a man with an unclean spirit (Mark 1:23), healing a man who was deaf (Mark 7:32) and making whole another who was blind (Mark 8:22). Matthew, however, writes that on 23 occasions Jesus blessed a total of 47 people. Some of those whom he bestowed God's grace to include a leper (Matthew 8:2), a non-Israelite woman and her daughter (Matthew 15:22), Mary Magdalene (Matthew 27:56) and Joseph of Arimathaea (Matthew 27:57).

Luke writes that on 14 occasions 94 people were blessed. They include the seventy

disciples sent out to preach and heal (Luke 10:1), ten lepers cleansed at the same time (Luke 17:12) and Zaccheus (Luke 19:2). Lastly, the apostle John bears record of 8 incidents where 9 people were helped by Jesus. Nicodemus (John 3:1), the woman accused of adultery (John 8:11) and Lazarus (John 11) are among those personally touched by the Savior of mankind.

All told, the Lord directly blessed a grand total of 153 people in 48 separate incidents!

Just one reminder about that fish harvest. The Holy Spirit makes sure that we realize the NET DID NOT BREAK. If a net breaks what happens? Fish get away. Nope this story tells us so many important things but do not fail to see that if you are a caught fish, you are going to get harvested and you are not getting away.

“When we’ve been there 10,000 years” we will look back at this small, 1984+ year period of time, and this time will probably be referred to as “The Season of Pentecost” forever.

We have much to learn. Do not think you have even skimmed the surface of the meaning of this number **153**. I have seen so much more. If I get too detailed here you will get lost in it. There is so much wonderful information in this number in fact that I think God is truly smiling that this **153** fish count, when added to the number of fish that Jesus already caught that day (assuming 14 because you are reading this therefore it was not 7) can be applied from the SECOND GREAT AMERICAN ECLIPSE OF 8/21/2017, this **153 + 14 = 167** fish for a day count brings you to February 4, 2018. You must understand that you are one of the fish here. You were caught, you did not get away, you could not get away.

Though the count apparently was not 153 days from the eclipse of 8/21 we now have appropriately been informed perhaps that we need to add fish and add days.

## THE THIRD COUNT. 120 DAYS *UNTIL* PENTECOST!

### **Romans 11:11 King James Version (KJV)**

**11** I say then, Have they stumbled that they should fall? God forbid: but *rather* through their fall salvation *is come* unto the Gentiles, for to **provoke them to jealousy.**

So I go to a date calculator. I put in January 21, 2018 as the beginning day 1. I want to add 120 days. Which I do...and calculate...and it brings me inclusively to May 20/21, 2018. So, then armed with May 20/21, 2018, I go to Torahcalendar.com to see what is on May 20/21, 2018. And of course, it is THE ACTUAL DAY OF PENTECOST!!!!

A rapture date that in any manner calculates to 120 days from a Resurrection Sign, AND 120 days until Pentecost, will cause some to go back to Acts 2 and re-think what happened on that Pentecost, just 50 days after this Jesus (who some are saying WAS the Messiah) was resurrected, had appeared, and ascended and 10 days later...well, wait, isn't Pentecost a Jewish feast? Does it have anything to do with the rest of the world?

Let's go look at Luke's Acts 2 when Pentecost occurred and see if there is any GENTILE element....

*Parthians, and Medes, and Elamites, and the dwellers in Mesopotamia, and in Judaea, and Cappadocia, in Pontus, and Asia,*  
2:9 The long list of nations embraces the various races embraced in the we of Ac 2:8:

**Parthians.** Parthia was east of the Tigris.

**Medes.** Media, another part of the Medo-Persian empire, east of the Tigris.

**Elamites.** Elam was an ancient name of Persia.

**Mesopotamia** was the seat of Babylon. These four countries just named were thickly populated with Jews descended from those carried into captivity by Nebuchadnezzar.

**Cappadocia.** A Roman province not far from the Black Sea.

**Pontus.** A province south and east of the Black Sea.

**Asia.** The Roman province of which Ephesus was the capital. All the seven churches were in the province called Asia (Re 1:4,11).

**Acts 2:10**

*Phrygia, and Pamphylia, in Egypt, and in the parts of Libya about Cyrene, and strangers of Rome, Jews and proselytes,*

2:10 **Phrygia, and Pamphylia.** Parts of what is called Asia Minor.

**Egypt.** The great African province where many ten thousands of Jews had their home.

**Parts of Libya.** Of Africa.

**About Cyrene.** A great Grecian city on the coast west of Egypt. It is said that one-fourth of the population of Cyrene was Jewish.

**Strangers of Rome.** Roman Jews sojourning at Jerusalem.

**Proselytes.** Gentiles who had been converted to Judaism.

This count of 120+14 days focusing on a net rapture and Pentecost is designed to let the Jews know that we, being truly children of Abraham by faith, are as much a child of God as the Jews. We, however, by faith, have preceded them to Glory. Will this fact do what it is supposed to do? Cause Israel to be jealous? Yes for some, but not all. As for the rest of humanity? It will not cause the remainder of the world to be jealous. The remainder of the world will join Antichrist in blaspheming not only God, but THOSE WHO DWELL IN HEAVEN. Saints! That's you! Think of it. You get to make Antichrist mad. What joy!

There is Glory here for God Saints.

#### 4.

### REQUIRES A DANIEL 12:4 NEW REVELATION ABOUT JOHN

#### **Daniel 12:4 King James Version (KJV)**

**4** But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.

Some will teach that the knowledge that is increased includes the technological knowledge that is changing our society. I am sure that is encompassed in the wisdom that God gives us here. Some scholars suggest that it is the Book that people are running to and fro over. In other words. God will continue to give knowledge about even the "time of the end" if we run to and fro, across the pages of the Book. This is certainly not an improper way to view that verse. What Book? Could be the Book of Daniel. Could be the whole Bible.

So, this "new" revelation about an end to the Pentecost Season is understood if we treat Israel as a separate corporate entity from the Church, a totally different corporate entity. To consider an END OF A PENTECOST SEASON, was not even on the radar for Israel until the mystery of the existence of the Church came up and Paul explained that there will be a point in time, a termination of Pentecost, when the living and the dead, all who are in Christ are raised. Daniel 12:4 is being fulfilled and new understandings are obtained as we go over and over the Book and as we experience the EXACT and recent signs in the Sun, Moon and Stars that God told us to expect here in these last days. It is not inconceivable that He will count from those signs. Why else are they there.

After the count to conceive the Church started in Acts 2, and they counted past the seven Sabbaths and got to the morrow after, at the third hour of the day, that is when the Holy Spirit went into action and began creating the first **120** of the Church. Then later the 3,000, then later, every new man, every person who has EVER become a part of the Church of Jesus Christ.

## 5.

### **PENTECOST MUST END WITH A HARVEST.**

#### **Acts 2: King James Version (KJV)**

**1** And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.

**2** And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.

**3** And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.

**4** And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

**5** And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven.

Chuck Missler is fond of saying, "The past is prologue." Ever so true with Pentecost because in these verses from the inception of Pentecost, we understand what the conclusion of Pentecost will be like.

Pentecost is not only a day that occurred in Acts 2, but it was the initializing, the conception of the church. The church needs to be completed, born again and in order for that to happen the group known as "THE CHURCH" needs to be a closed group after its 1984+ year membership drive. This thing called THE CHURCH started in Acts 2 after a BEGINNING OF PENTECOST COUNT. What was started has not ended as people are still becoming Christians. The Holy Spirit is still falling on new Christians and lighting them up and making them new creatures. What is the count for the END OF THE PENTECOST SEASON when the Holy Spirit stops doing this? Why would He stop? This has been great! It stops because God did not design this season to last forever. It ends with a harvest.

**THE COUNT FOR THE BEGINNING OF THE CHURCH AGE MAY NOT BE THE SAME AS THE COUNT FOR THE END OF THE CHURCH AGE.**

The ongoing "effect" or "season" of Pentecost ends with the rapture at the LAST DAY, the end of the END OF PENTECOST COUNT, because after that, the group known as "The Church" is closed by virtue of the fact that at the rapture, the ENTIRE CHURCH is made incorruptible and eternal.

Pentecost, a Divine Appointment which we now know allows for at least 1,984 more years of individual divine appointments with God as individuals, which

individuals, one at a time, are indwelt eternally with the Holy Spirit. Pentecost in Acts 2 was a picture, from the beginning of the church, OF THE END OF THE CHURCH: the rapture. When the season of Pentecost is over, the **120** disciples in Acts 2, AND all the rest of THE CHURCH, living and dead (including those **120**) will be

- 1) gathered, (think harpadzoed)
- 2) in an upper room, (think throne room)
- 3) joyous, (oh yes)
- 4) in one accord, (finally we will all be in agreement! In fact, after being on websites where different ideas are considered, now I even see a miracle that there could have been even 120 in one accord!!!! I'm laughing as I write)
- 5) speaking but one language, (Babel reversed)
- 6) lit up and shiny. (not just lit upon but changed to glory)
- 7) from every nation. (can a nation be born in a day?)

All of these elements are exactly what we will see at the Rapture of the Church at the TERMINATION OF PENTECOST.

**NEW MEAT! WE JUST DON'T READ CAREFULLY ENOUGH. THERE IS MORE TO HARVEST IF WE GLEAN, GLEAN, GLEAN, AND IF WE GO OVER AND OVER THE BOOK. Daniel 12:4**

Leviticus 23:15-16 King James Version (KJV)

**15** And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the sabbath, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven sabbaths shall be complete:

**16** Even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath shall ye number fifty days; (↑) and ye shall offer **a new meat offering unto the Lord.**

May I direct your attention to the words highlighted in red above in the verse box were it reads “**a new meat offering unto the Lord.**”

If I was to ask you on a test (I used to enjoy giving my adult Sunday School class students a test) the following question:

In 25 words or less explain what the concept of “**a new meat offering unto the Lord**” means to you and how it encourages you...

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There, you have something? I bet it is quite a blessing. Share it with your boss, or your mother in law. Hah! Listen...”I’m just one old hungry beggar, showing you where I found food.” John Fischer. Let me show you something that filled me up.

Whenever Pentecost terminates, and this has never before occurred in history so attempting to find out exactly from Bible history books what occurs when a Pentecost Season is terminated, what will follow will be **a new meat offering unto the Lord**? We are raptured to the throne with nothing. We have no money, we have no grain, we have no works, we have absolutely nothing but what God has given us. We have our clothing, fine shining linen, but that was provided by Him as well. We have a living body. What can we offer as **a new meat offering unto the Lord**?

Well the question might be better answered if we knew exactly what “New Meat” was. Here is your clue. It seems that “new meat” is a reference to grain that has JUST BEEN HARVESTED. At first fruits it was a new meat offering.

When Jesus fulfilled the divine appointment of First Fruits. He was resurrected anew. Jesus Himself was grain that HAS JUST BEEN HARVESTED.

This is born out in Numbers 28:26 Also in the day of the First Fruits, when ye bring a **new meat** offering unto the LORD, after your weeks *be out*, ye shall have an holy convocation; ye shall do no servile work:

Continuing the grain theme which God used to assist the agrarian Israelites to learn this important truth, Jesus was “harvested” with His resurrection. **He and His blood were presented to God as a new meat offering after His resurrection** and after meeting with Mary, whom He had to tell to stop trying to touch Him because He had not yet ascended to the Father. When did that happen? Not 40 days later but immediately after He met with Mary outside the tomb. That is why when Jesus met doubting Thomas about a week later, the response of Jesus to Thomas’ bewilderment at His appearing was to offer “put your hands in the wounds.”

However, when we get to the period when the Church has already been initiated at Pentecost in Acts 2, and it has been an additional 1984 Gregorian years (thank you Enoch for your rapture at 365 years to point out to us the importance of Gregorian years and dates here at the end and maybe even permission to begin counting the Psalms of Ascent on Sunday, January 20/21 and look at each Psalm of Ascent number as a Gregorian calendar date) to the present, and we have all the signs, then, we are not talking about the termination of First Fruits (the resurrection of Jesus) and counting (to the initialization of Pentecost)...instead, we are talking about the termination of Pentecost and

**counting .....**

from some, future sign to occur, in the sun, moon and stars which could be interpreted to be the SECOND GREAT RESURRECTION SIGN OF 9/23/2017, ...or

from, some, future sign to occur, in the sun, moon and stars like the SECOND GREAT AMERICAN ECLIPSE of 8/21/2017, ...or ...**BOTH**,

**counting to**

ANOTHER HARVEST. The termination and fulfillment and Harvest of Pentecost. The harvest of the Church at the rapture perhaps on 2/04/2018. (or later if the disciples were really pounding down the fish at breakfast.)

But, we are back to it, what do you have with you after being raptured so as to make the required offering of **a new meat offering unto the Lord?**

I think Scripture indicates, by the fact that at First Fruits, the High Priest lifted an ephah of barley in the air as part of that celebration, that that bunch of barley stalks, lifted in the air, represented Jesus Christ being resurrected and ascending to the Father to present His blood an offering for sin. That is how Jesus fulfilled First Fruits and it started a count to Pentecost.

Then, at Pentecost, the next divine appointment, the High Priest lifted two loaves of bread into the air representing I think, both Jews and Gentiles who when COMPLETE (loaves are many many many grains having been processed, made complete into loaves) are the Church and each one of us, who are harvested, are thus an individual grain that becomes a part of the "new meat" which is part of that offering and that loaf. Once again, at the rapture, you are called "New Meat" because you were just harvested. This all confirms a connection to the termination of Pentecost and the harvest of Pentecost and that is what my entire thread is about.

Yes, the instructions we're made for the Jews but the subject behind it all, mysteriously, IS ALL ABOUT THE RAPTURE OF THE CHURCH and we can learn from it even if at the rapture, we don't have two loaves of new meat to raise in the air.

When the question about the required offering of **a new meat offering unto the Lord** after the rapture is presented to you... please understand Saints! **You are** the offering of **new meat** that is brought to God. Further, **you are** now a priest unto the order of Melchizedek. You Saint, are the one offering yourself as a new meat (just been harvested) offering to God. When you see the incredible beauty that surrounds you and beckons you and the gifts that God has given you, what else could you do? You offer yourself as a sacrifice of new meat and you cast your crowns to Him.

Do you see our connection to our Lord Jesus? He, post resurrection, also offered Himself as a new meat offering to God and He Himself was the both the offering

and the presenter (the priest) of that offering to God. Now, it is our turn. At the rapture, we will offer ourselves as a new meat offering unto the Lord and as priests in the kingdom, we will be authorized to accomplish it.

## 7.

### CONCLUSION ON THESE POINTS

These first six points are essential to this idea.

1) The 1<sup>st</sup> sign: THE SECOND GREAT RESURRECTION SIGN OF September 23, 2017 may be a sign from God about the Resurrection of the Church to occur **120+14** days later. Psalm 120 – Psalm 134 are the Psalms of “Ascent.”

2) The 2<sup>nd</sup> sign: THE SECOND GREAT AMERICAN ECLIPSE OF August 21, 2017 may be a sign from God about the last day of redemption and repentance (how to get in the net) and that day will occur **153+14** days later if the disciples had 2 fish each.

3) The 3<sup>rd</sup> sign: **PENTECOST 2018** OCCURS ON THE DATE **120** DAYS AFTER January 21, 2017, which day itself fulfilled 120 and 153 day counts. Amazingly, on the date the count ends, that unknown date, becomes a date on which a count to the actual date of Pentecost begins. Jealousy is the goal!

4) We are given a count about Pentecost in Leviticus 23:15 & 16 and what happened to the disciples after that count that was used by God at the FIRST GREAT RESURRECTION SIGN (Jesus resurrection) at Pentecost in Acts 2 gives information about what will occur at the termination of Pentecost and when.

5) What was started at Pentecost (conception of the Church) has to end and I am suggesting in this article that it will end when an “unexpected” count is used that signifies redemption and Pentecost and that count will be completed on February 4, 2018 or on some other Sunday before May 20/21, 2018 Pentecost.

6) The rapture means we will make a different kind of living sacrifice at the Throne Room. When the rapture is completed in a moment of time, there will be **a new meat offering unto the Lord in heaven. First it was our Head, Jesus Christ, offering the “new meat” sacrifice. Now it is the body, the entire Church, who will join the Head.**

God is now going to make Israel jealous. Saints, soon we will hear the LAST Trump of God. Oh my, when it was first heard at Sinai the people were afraid, in fact so afraid, they figured, “Let’s just send Moses by himself.” That trump was no

trumpet blown by man. That was the trumpet blown by God. At Pentecost there was a “mighty rushing wind.” I like to preach that this was simply God preserving the type, and it could be here at Pentecost in Acts 2 is where God is taking a deep breath for His trumpet sound at the rapture. O.K. doesn’t have to be, but it preaches well. Now for “Just As I Am!” Hah!

Having discovered again the value and uniqueness of the Psalms of Ascent, I am going to use them as I count down to the end of the fishy John 21 count. If it does not occur then...well at least I will have been blessed and this preparation, based on Scripture, will not be void or go to waste.

Once you begin to believe it, then God can work to encourage your hearts. If you are hanging on the outside, refusing to believe God could have given us knowledge about a date that means so much to Him, and you can't see it or you refuse to see it. I understand your position.

It is what C.S. Lewis referred to in one of his essays in God In The Dock. I remember the name now, "Meditations in a Toolshed." Lewis went into a dusty shed and light came through the ceiling in a distinct sunbeam. He looked at the sunbeam from the outside and saw the dust particles going through the beam of light. It was beautiful and mysterious. Then he moved into the beam... AND LOOKED UP! He saw the whole world out there bright and shining. He remarked at how breathtaking it was. Seeing the sunbeam from the outside and just looking at it is one thing. That is what many members and guests of Unsealed are doing right now on this thread and their threads. Standing in the sunbeam in belief and looking up into the incredible shining world up there is a totally different and wonderful vision. Same beam, different views. You can join me if you wish.
