

The Psalms of Ascent – 2 of 15 – 1/08/2018

Psalm 121

I will be posting these Psalms with commentary as I go through them, one each day, until the end date of 1/21/2018.

FROM THE SECOND GREAT RESURRECTION SIGN OF 9/23/2017

There is a **120** day count for each of the **120** Pentecost Saints in the Upper Room and a **120** day count for each “condemning” Men of Nineveh times a thousand countdown, both ending on **1/21/2018**.

FROM THE SECOND GREAT AMERICAN ECLIPSE OF 8/21/2017

There is a **153** day for a miraculously caught and kept fish countdown that ends on **1/21/2018**..

I learned two things about the **153** day countdown today. One, I was reminded by the Lord that Elijah’s episode with the three groups of **fifty** was actually a group of **fifty** and a **captain of fifty** for each group. That would be **three groups of fifty-one**. **153** is how many are dealt with in 2 Kings 1. In the next chapter, 2 Kings 2, there is a rapture. “**153**” again, connected to a rapture.

Two, I learned that the volume in the six measures of wine where Jesus turned the water into wine, breaks down into 153 units. Amazing. A connection to new wine, first miracle, and the Church which is indicated to be new wine in a new wine skin.

If whenever the rapture occurs, the rapture being the Harvest that terminates Pentecost, then Leviticus 23:16 suggests to you that you should be preparing to make a **living sacrifice of "New Meat" to God**, after whatever count God uses to bring us home. I suggest you use these Psalms to get your heart right. They have been named the Psalms of Ascent from the beginning.

Leviticus 23: 15 And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the sabbath, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven sabbaths shall be complete: 16 Even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath shall ye number fifty days; (THEN AN UNKNOWN PERIOD OF TIME GOES BY) and ye shall offer a new meat offering unto the LORD.

"New Meat" means grain that HAS JUST been harvested. Saint! That's YOU! The Pentecost season will end with a harvest. Next Pentecost in Spring will not work because the SECOND GREAT RESURRECTION SIGN on 9/23/2017 started the 120 “**day for a Pentecost Saint**” count and prior to that the SECOND GREAT AMERICAN ECLIPSE OF 8/21/2017 started the 153 “**day for a fish**” count to all end on 1/21/2018.

I am so grateful that God gave me this insight so I can go through each of these Psalms AGAIN as I wait for Him. In the last day or so, though I have taught on them for years, and some I have put to music so I can sing them, I have seen **for now the second time** the value of using these 15 Psalms of Ascent (Psalm 120 through 134) in a way that God truly prescribed. He wants us to get our hearts ready for the throne room. You'll be taking that "heart" part of you up there with you you know. So get it ready!

Not only do I love His appearing, but when one loves it you must love His Scriptures that over and over and over and over confirm His appearing in every detail. There have been those that have told me over and over that these things I have presented from Scripture here are just my opinion. However, it was God who helped me even get to an opinion. Your opinion of me or my opinions or how I present my opinions has faded into the not

important bin. I know still that Jesus said most Christians will find Him coming like a thief in the night. They will be surprised. Kind of embarrassing with all that is here to get us ready, but what a loving Lord we have. He still comes. He still redeems. Even though we do not deserve it.

This now, after God gave me the purpose of the Psalms of Ascent, has become personal to me. I cannot convince anyone, or few anyway, so instead, I will allow some to watch from the outside while I (and perhaps others as time goes on) engage in a process where I have to prepare my heart and I am going to do it the way God wants. Prepare and count. The Psalms of Ascent. "Thank you Lord for allowing me to see the real use of these Scriptures! and well before the end day of the count so the words can soak in my heart."

I love His appearing and I want that crown! I want to have it so that I can give it back to Him because it was only He that allowed me to see all the confirmations that are there in Scripture and which, admittedly, so poorly I tried to faithfully teach. I know there are those that disagree with the idea. I will still read those disagreements (with a smile) and I am happy to read them but it won't bother me. I am not giving up on what God has given me.

What this means is that with belief, the words of Scripture come even more alive...It is as if my Lord were speaking directly to me, a part of the Philadelphian Church...

I will lift up my eyes to the mountains; ("LOOK UP"

From where shall my help come? (if we are getting out of here it will only be because of Him coming to save us! We don't need suggestions we need Salvation!)

My help comes from the Lord, (Here He comes in the clouds! Angels aplenty, God's last trump, a tumult at the throne!)

Who made heaven and earth. (Yes! We all will get to see the real heaven and earth that day! Finally we get to know the truth! What have we been educated with and what have we been programmed with? Now we find out!)

He will not allow your foot to slip; (Memorize this for your first steps up towards heaven in an incorruptible body! You won't fall. Every fish makes it. The net does not break Saint!)

He who keeps you will not slumber. (Hah! Understatement! Laughable because of the tumult at the throne!)

4

Behold, He who keeps Israel (Now He will turn His attention to Israel. He has kept the Church. The net of 153 fish was not torn. Not one was lost. Same for Israel. All to be saved will be saved.)

Will neither slumber nor sleep. (and business will be quite busy 24/7 for at least 7 years)

5

The Lord is your keeper; (He kept every believer, every member of the Church, for this moment. The new wine, the Gentile Church is full. The measurement of the wine at Cana gets us to 153 also!)

The Lord is your shade on your right hand. (He is also the light of heaven, protecting Saints raptured at noon from sun)

6

The sun will not smite you by day, (In Heaven, the sun is close but the true light that reflects off the firmament is from the Lord. The sun smites with heat. The moon smites with cold.)

Nor the moon by night. (When raptured, some will experience rising towards the sun, some to moon, it will happen at same time all over the earth.)

7

The Lord will [a]protect you from all evil; (If raptured we are taken through the second heaven, Satan's domain. We will be victorious. He will be thrown down.)

He will keep your soul. (If raptured our souls will have been kept and redeemed!)

8

The Lord will [b]guard your going out and your coming in (We, members of the Church, will be traveling beings all during the millennium. We will be going the service of the King. We will have honor, the honor that comes from the Father.)

From this time forth and forever. (And that will continue forever, who knows where the Church might be sent during the millennium, and who knows the plans of God for after that?)

As the days wind down I will be looking at the remaining 13 of the 15 Psalms of Ascent, to prepare my heart for that one ascent which will be the most amazing ascent that will ever have occurred in history. I will be going up to make a living sacrifice of new meat. Wait! Jesus did it once. He was the Head. Now we will connect the body to the Head.
