

After doing the “Big Event” letter a few times, in error of course, It looks like hindsight has now caught up with the here and now.

Part 1...

1. From the Dome of the Rock in 688 AD to the **end** of 2023 was the completion of the 1335 day/years. (688+1335=2023). So then on April 8/9 of 2024 (Nisan 1) the very next actual day after the 1335 day/yr closed out, there was that total eclipse which darkened the sun, and it was a new moon (black moon) just like Mat 24:29 where you read that “**Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light,,,**”

However, there is a part 2...

2. Both Rev 6:12 and Joel 2:31 talk about both the Darkened sun AND the blood moon happening just before the “day of Lord”. The second part just occurred on March 13/14, which is **before** next Hebrew year, Nisan 1 (March 30/31) time frame. So both the Darkened sun and blood moon occurred within one Hebrew year from Nisan 1, 2024 to just before Nisan 1, 2025

3. That lines up with the 2nd woe in Rev 11 as being complete just before the 7th trumpet sounds - [Rev_11:14](#) The second **woe** is past; *and*, behold, the third **woe** cometh quickly. Then -[Rev_11:15](#) And the seventh angel **sounded**;

4. The half-hour of Rev 8:1 is about 7.6 days (365.25 / 24 / 2) using a day= a year. So that would mean that after the rapture/resurrection there would be a 7 day wait until the “day of the Lord” would start

Finally...

5. A side note is that on Nisan 10 (this year it's April 8, 2025), which is the same **day** (Nisan 10) that our Lord rode in humbly on a donkey. This time, it seems, that he may ride triumphantly in on a white horse on the very same day! BTW that would be exactly 1 solar year from the above mentioned solar eclipse date of April 8, 2024

Conclusion:

I had thought that the Lord was coming at the end of 2023, due to the 1335 part, but someone else pointed out an interesting parable in Luke 13: (KJV)

[Luk 13:6](#) He spake also this parable; **A certain man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard; and he came and sought fruit thereon, and found none.**

[Luk 13:7](#) Then said he unto the dresser of his vineyard, Behold, these three years I come seeking fruit on this fig tree, and find none: cut it down; why cumbereth it the ground?

[Luk 13:8](#) And he answering said unto him, Lord, let it alone this year also, till I shall dig about it, and dung *it*:

[Luk 13:9](#) And if it bear fruit, *well*: and if not, *then* after that thou shalt cut it down.

So, that makes the “day of the Lord” **one year later**, at the end of 2024 of the

Hebrew calendar, IE 2025. Bottom line is that 7 days **before** Nisan 1 (March 30/31, 2025) could be the rapture/resurrection. That would be NOW.

Then there is the Jubilee cycle that lands on 2025, which is another whole subject altogether.

That's my latest take at the moment, but we'll see what happens I guess.
