

# CHRIST STARS OF THE MESSIAH

## JUPITER-VENUS CONJUNCTIONS FROM -3 BC TO 2032 AD

The purpose of this illustration is to ascertain the cosmic pattern of the Jupiter-Venus conjunctions from 2010-2032. In astronomical terms, the Jupiter-Venus Conjunctions occur on almost a yearly basis. This Planetary Conjunction is deemed the 'Star of Bethlehem'. This is an error, although innocent enough, Jupiter was the Star seen by the Magi as they traveled to Bethlehem as it rose over the Horizon looking South. This occurred on December 25, -2 BC. This is when the Magi arrived at the birthplace of Jesus as He was already 15 months old. This would put the timeframe of Jesus' birth in -3 BC, around September. Jupiter then had a triple conjunction with the King Star of Regulus. But it was the Jupiter-Venus Conjunction on August 11, -3BC in the Face of Leo that announced the birth of Jesus 1 month prior. So, the more accurate rendering of the Jupiter-Venus Conjunction should be considered the 'Stars of the Christ'. What was spectacular is that the same Jupiter-Venus Conjunction occurred on July 1, 2015. Many considered this event the 'Return of the Bethlehem Star'.
